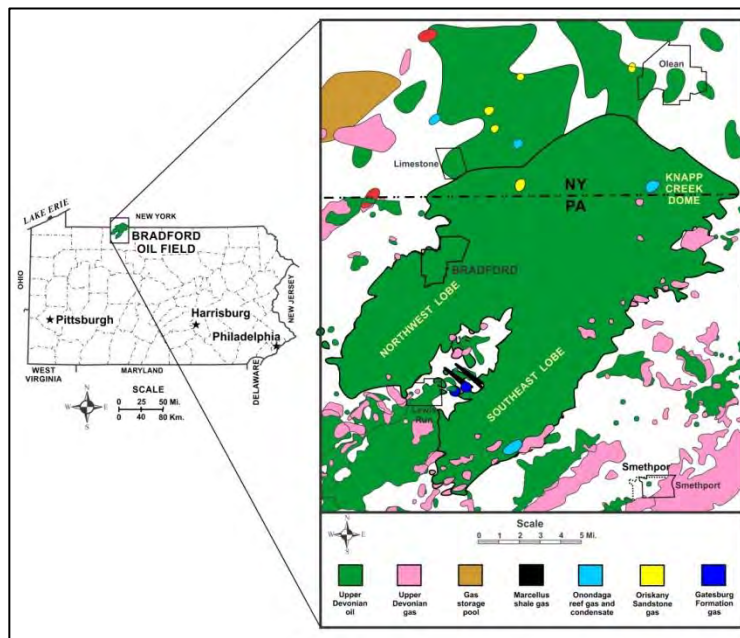

The Petroleum History Institute is seeking papers and posters to be presented at its annual meeting in Bradford, Pennsylvania, June 19-21, 2014. Any oil history related topic is welcome, but especially welcome are topics related to the development of the oil fields in the Bradford region and southern New York. Examples include technological innovations, history of key individuals/families/companies, progression over a particular geological area, oil field traditions, preservation of oil history, and educational materials about the history of petroleum/oil/natural gas industry.

Papers are typically presented in person as approximately 20 minute talks including Q/A, often including visuals such as PowerPoint or slides. Posters are not oral presentations; they are silent visual boards which include photographs, maps, diagrams, text on a specific topic. Full papers will be published in the *Oil-Industry History* after the review process.

Abstract text should be 600 words, or fewer; format: Title, author and address (mailing and email), body of text (600 words or fewer). Please send the submitted abstract to the email address below:
